A meeting was held at The Prince Edward Hotel in Windsor at 8 pm June 2^{nd} , 1961 to discuss the filling of all Camp weeks. The Camp was opened for July 7^{th} and closed on Labor Day.

The Fall Meeting was held at the Windsor Club, Prince Edward Hotel in Windsor on December 8th, 1961. During 1961, lumber for new docks was purchased for \$220.68, new blankets, pillows and kitchenware were purchased for \$370.85. A net profit of \$243.87 was reported for the year. The total number of camp days was up from 206 in 1960 to 233 in 1961 giving the Camp \$3,175.50 in revenue.
