Larry Ancypa looked into the purchase of a new pontoon boat. The Board initially looked for a stripped down model for around \$5,000.00 , noted in the October 1989 Minutes. A name for the boat was discussed with Al Glover suggesting Lil Beaver which was thought to be a little racy for on the lake and in the end the boat was named the “Pussy Kat”. Also the membership voted to allow a bank loan for up to \$4,000.00 to help cover the costs of the high number of maintenance items required this year. A 28 HP Evenrude motor was purchased for the Pussy Kat and brought to Camp by Larry Ancypa.

Three new motors were purchased for the Camp during 1989.

Camp help was discussed at the Annual General Meeting and many Camps had let it be known they were not interested in proceeding with a cooks and camp help. This motion was considered by the membership which decided to keep looking for help. John Haddow Sr. was given the task of finding some Camp Help. None was found at a price that proved satisfactory so help was not hired. The cost for Camp Help would have run \$450.00 to \$500.00 per week but the membership put a cap on the amount of \$350.00 per week.

The use of a standard form to calculate Camp fees and submit them was voted on and passed at the October Meeting. This started in the 1990 season.

John Haddow Jr. and John Kerr both resigned from the Board of Directors. Two other positions were open as their terms were completed. Four members were elected to fill the vacancies.

Due to the repairs and expenditures during the year and items on the priority list for 1990, the Camp had to borrow money from the bank. The members authorized the Board to borrow up to \$4,000.00 to cover these costs. One item discussed was replacement of old bedding supplied for members by the Camp. It was decided to stop supplying the linens and make it the responsibility of each member to bring their own.
