## 2018 Projects:

Spring Board Meeting held at the home of Dennis Pettit (London, Ontario) on April 15th

AGM held at Quality Inn in Sarnia on October 21st

13 of 42 members attended – 16 proxies received

Notable motions made and approved at AGM:

- Up to \$1200 CAD for purchase of log splitter
- Up to \$5500 CAD for purchase or construction of a new North dock
- Up to \$300 CAD to repair exhaust manifold on Onan generator
- Up to \$1500 CAD for replacement of the boathouse roof using steel panels
- Up to \$1000 for purchase of (2) solar panels to augment the battery system
- An dues assessment of \$50 for 2019 was approved to raise funds for projects. This brings dues for 2019 to \$450 for current (not new) members. The Board is to come up with a list of potential projects to be done by regular camps to receive a credit on camp fees.

- Lower initiation fee for the next two years to \$10 CAD to encourage new/younger members and increase participation in camp
- Camp fees for members and relatives increased for both off-season and in-season
  - Member rates are \$25/day for off-season (+\$5.00) & \$35/day for in-season (+\$3.00)
  - o Relative rates are \$35/day for off season (+3.00) & \$60/day for in-season (+\$2.00)
  - O Guest rates remain the same at \$38/day for off season & \$64/day for in-season
  - o Child rate (under age 19) remain at 50% of applicable off-season or in-season rate

Dennis Pettit's term on the Board expired and Mark Farmer and Rob Haddow were voted to new 3 year terms on the Board of Directors.

Nine new member nominations were made and approved for 2019. Nominated were Vic Kinsella, Jim Kinsella, Carl Rockburn, Tyler Smale, Kirk Farmer, Mike Foster, Paul Lutovicz, Chris Oscada and Marc Thorup.
